

Petal 2
Cast on 18 sts using red yarn
Row 1-4: As Petal 1 but ending with 24 sts
Row 5-12: Reduce knit rows to 5 sts in same way as in Petal 1. Alternate rows - Purl

[OR make 2 identical petals]

For Centre
Cast on 1 sts using black yarn.
Row 1 (RS): kfb, 3 sts
Row 2 and 4: Purl.
Row 3: kfb, kfb, k1, 5 sts
Row 5: Skpo, k1, k2tog, 3 sts
Row 6: P3tog.

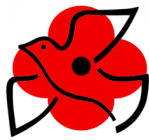
OR use black button, or circle of black felt and sew in place.

Fasten off. Sew ends into back of circle, pulling in slightly to create a circular shape on the RS. Overlap the two inner edges of the petals in the centre. Sew in place.
Take yarn through to back and fasten off.
Add black circle of felt, knitted centre or black button, on top of the petals right in the centre.
Stitch in place.

Abbreviations
kfb knit into the front and back of the stitch, thus making a stitch
Skpo slip one stitch, knit one stitch, pass slipped stitch over
P2tog purl two stitches together, thus decreasing by one stitch
K2tog knit two stitches together, thus decreasing by one stitch
P3tog purl three stitches together, thus decreasing by two stitches

Poppy Petals
Petal 1
Cast on 14 sts using red yarn.
This is the outer edge of the petal.

Row 1 (RS): kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k1, 16 sts
Row 2 and 3: As Row 1, 20 sts
Row 4: Purl.
Row 5: k1, (skpo, k2) rep to last st, k1, 15 sts
Row 6: Purl.
Row 7: k1, (skpo, k1) rep to last 2 sts, skpo, 10 sts
Row 8: (P2tog) rep to end, 5 sts
Cast off. This is the inner edge of the petal.

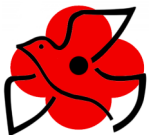

You will need:

Oddments of red DK yarn
(about 5g)
Oddments of black DK yarn
(less than 5g)
Pair 4mm (Size 8) needles



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
