

Cast of last 3 sts.

Row 17: K1, sl 1 pss0 twice, K1.

Rows 14 - 16: Knit

Row 13: As row 9 [5 sts]

Rows 10 - 12: Knit

Row 9: SSK twice, k to last 4 sts, k2tog twice [9sts]

Rows 5 - 8: Knit

Row 4: As row 2 [13sts]

Row 3: As row 2 [11sts]

Row 2: KFB, k to last 2 sts, KFB, k 1 [9sts]

Row 1: Knit (R side of work)

Cast on 7 sts

**Petals - (Make 4)**

Pss0 = pass sl.st over, Tog = together

k 2 tog.,

SSK = (slip next two sts onto 'R' needle, slip back and

St(s) = stitch(es),

KFB = knit into front and back of st.,

K = knit,

**Finishing Off**

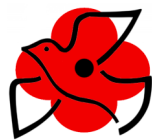
Joining cast off edges, sew petals together in pairs.

Place one pair over the other and sew in place.

Overlap petals (as picture or 'r' over 'l') and secure with a couple of sts).

Add a black button, small round of black felt or a small black pom-pom.
