 - Name
 - Address
 - Contact telephone number and email
 - Where the image was taken
- Parental consent must be included for all entrants 12 years of age and under.

- Entries will be judged by a panel appointed by the church.

- Entrants retain the copyright of their image. Entering the competition grants us the right to
